

# WELCOME TO HOWARD UNIVERSITY Immunization Requirement Instructions

Fall Semester Deadline- June 1st /Spring Semester Deadline- December 1st

### **How to Complete Forms:**

- Go to https://howard.studenthealthportal.com. Download your Immunization Certificate under "Related Links" for your health care provider to complete.
- Once the form has been completed by your medical provider, enter the vaccine dates from the Immunization Form onto the Immunization Record in your patient portal. Upload the completed immunization form and complete the online TB screening forms.
- The online TB screening Form, a signed Immunization Certificate, and the Online Immunization Form must be completed to have your medical hold lifted!
- Non-Health Science Students 26 years of age & older Online TB screening Form

#### Important information for students who plan to live on campus:

- A Meningococcal vaccine administered after age 16 is required for students who wish to live in University Housing.
- The Meningococcal vaccine is mandatory for all students residing on campus.
- Students who are unable to receive the vaccine due to medical or religious reasons are not eligible to live on campus. The students must find other housing accommodations.

# IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

VACCINATION	DOSE REQUIREMENT
MMR	<ul> <li>2 doses</li> <li>1 dose on or after 1st birthday and 2nd at least 4 weeks after 1st dose</li> </ul>
Tetanus	Tdap or Td within the last 10 years
Hep B	<ul> <li>3 doses</li> <li>2nd dose given at least 4 weeks after 1st &amp; 3rd at least 8 weeks after 2nd</li> <li>Hep B vaccination series that includes only 2 doses are accepted</li> </ul>
Varicella	<ul> <li>2 doses</li> <li>History of disease (Provide Month &amp; Year)</li> </ul>
Polio (if under the age of 18)	• 3 doses
Meningitis ACWY or Men B	• 1 dose required after the age of 16

#### If you do not have a record of your immunizations:

- MMR
- Varicella
- Hepatitis B vaccine series

You must upload titers showing you are immune to satisfy the Immunization Requirements.

If the titer results indicate you are not immune, you are required to complete the vaccination series.

- Quantitative Titers for Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, & Varicella

#### OTHER DETAILS

- Positive Online TB
   screening forms require a
   TB Gold, TB Skin Test, or
   Chest X-Ray
- Meningococcal after the age of 16 is mandatory for all students living on campus.
